Dear Families,

After much consideration and after consulting with school districts and schools in St. Louis County and St. Louis City, and with the St. Louis County Department of Health, SSD will be closing its schools, programs, sites and operational facilities beginning Wednesday, March 18.

Our schools have prepared several different items based on your student's ability to access learning. You may be receiving information from your child's teacher and we have provided a list of several resources for our student and families to access.

1. Parents should contact the building principal (or designee) if their child cannot login to the digital platform.
2. Parents are encouraged to notify building principal if they do not hear from their student's instructor in a timely manner.
3. All parents will receive information on the hours that teachers are available to students.
4. Any family that does not have internet access should contact the building principal or designee and we will create a plan for this student.
5. All meetings including student/family, IEP, evaluations and re-evaluation will be rescheduled.
